- ★ The Nursery Unit is a purpose-built, self-contained building within the school grounds.
- ★ We have a bright and airy playroom, a kitchen, a Quiet Room and toilets with facilities for all.
- ★ Within our Outdoor Play area there are a variety of zones including a garden area, a slide, climbing walls, tunnels, a paved path for wheeled vehicles, sensory paths, a mud kitchen, music area, digging area and a quiet area as well as a role play cottage.
- ★ Both indoor and outdoor play are well catered for with a large range of safe, stimulating, educational and exciting play equipment.
- ★ We follow the 'Curricular Guidance for Pre-school Education'. This guidance is presented as six areas of learning: Personal, Social & Emotional Development, Language Development, Early Mathematical Experiences, Physical Development & Movement, The Arts and The World Around Us.



We have 26 full time places.

Nursery hours are 8:45am-1:15pm and this includes Snack Time & School Dinners.

Our Nursery Day begins at 8:45am. When the children come in they play until 10:45am. In nursery we have a Role Play Area, a Construction Area, a Writing Table, Art table, Painting Easel, Playdough Table, Small World Play Area and a Quiet Room for playing instruments, listening to music, reading stories or playing on the Interactive Whiteboard. During the morning the children also have access to our 'Under the Roof' area where they can play in the water tray, read, enjoy the mud kitchen as well as play with lots of different toys.
